2. Applicants are expected to be of at least Grade 8 standard and must be prepared to must be prepared to attend a competitive audition as the number of places is restricted.
3. Preference will be given to candidates who offer pieces which are designed for a full symphony orchestra.
4. Solihull Symphony Orchestra regrets that it cannot fund works which prove expensive to hire or which require unusual instruments. Performers must be prepared to cover such costs themselves or find an alternative work.
5. The decision of the Committee and Music Director is final.
6. The rehearsals will take place in the weeks prior to the concert and on the day of the concert, Saturday 14 March 2020
7. Once accepted for the concert a non-returnable fee of £50 will be required by 31 December 2019.
8. A high resolution photograph of the performer taken against a plain background must be provided within a fortnight of acceptance for the concert. When requested, performers must provide a brief biography which should include a reference to the work to be performed and the reasons behind the choice of this piece.
9. No sound or visual recording of the rehearsals, orchestra or concert may take place without the permission of the committee and the Music Director. No recording of the rehearsal or the concert is to be posted on social media or the internet.
10. Solihull Symphony Orchestra will be solely responsible for all publicity connected with the event.
